ACQUISITION OF SBM IN IVORY COAST

SBM was a joint subsidiary of Sea Containers Ltd (70%), the Antwerp based company Thornton & Co N.V. (20%) and Sipef N.V. (10%). Since the constitution of SBM in 1990, Sipef was in charge of the management of the 228 hectares of banana plantings and the marketing of the 7.000 tons produced.
